



Extra Mural Studies (EMS) in Malawi

The Lilongwe Society for the Protection and Care of Animals' (LSPCA) Veterinary Clinic and Centre for Animal Welfare provide the highest standards of veterinary care, veterinary training and animal welfare education in Lilongwe and surrounding villages.

LSPCA will provide a detailed volunteer information pack and you will be welcomed on arrival at the airport and comfortable accommodation is available on site.

Our work

You will participate in our structured clinical programme including:

- Consults and surgeries in our well-equipped Lilongwe clinic
- Village mobile spay/neuter and first aid clinics
- Farm animal clinics
- Donkey welfare project

You will also have the opportunity to participate in our clinical training programme for vet students at the local vet school.

This is an excellent opportunity to develop your clinical skills and attend to tropical diseases and cases you would not normally see at home. You will be supervised at all times by an experienced vet and we will work with your university to cover all EMS requirements. You are also welcome to join our schools education programme and other community activities and we are happy to advise you on safaris and visits to Lake Malawi if you want to add a few days holiday!

Cost

Placements are for a minimum of two weeks and start at £950 which includes: airport transfers, local SIM card, 2 t-shirts, accommodation on site, lunch on working days, full veterinary supervision and support from our volunteer co-ordinator. This does not include airfare, visa and vaccinations. LSPCA is a charity; your volunteer fee goes directly to supporting our work to care for animals in low income communities.
